Summer is an especially hungry time for the children in Collin County, over 44,000 or 20% of which are considered food insecure children who are actively struggling to find their next meal. In order to address this issue Plano Mayor Harry LaRosiliere has partnered with the North Texas Food Bank to work through the Food 4 Kids program to one day end hunger in North Texas.

"Food 4 Kids addresses the most fundamental need that we have as people – simple nourishment," says Plano Mayor Harry LaRosiliere. "The objective of Food 4 Kids is to feed our children, and inspire them to know their community cares."
